- Open session following each panel provides **OPPORTUNITY FOR BROAD PARTICIPATION**

WORKSHOP OUTPUTS

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- Two part report generated:
 - First part summarizes discussions from the workshop (sea ice, vegetation, terrestrial and marine), including:
 - Specific kinds of changes important to **LOCAL** people, **REGULATORS**, and **RESOURCE MANAGERS**
 - Data needs and processes capable of detecting and documenting these changes
 - Second part recommending ways to more effectively involve **LOCAL** people, **REGULATORS**, and **RESOURCE MANAGERS** in all phases of research
