North Slope Science Initiative Science Technical Advisory Panel to Meet in Anchorage

The North Slope Science Initiative (NSSI) Science Technical Advisory Panel (STAP) will meet Thursday and Friday, October 6 and 7, 2016 at the Bureau of Land Management Anchorage District Office, 4700 BLM Road, Anchorage, Alaska 99507. There will be an opportunity for public comment from 4:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. on October 6.

The NSSI is an intergovernmental effort to increase collaboration on the science needed to make informed decisions related to development and environmental change on Alaska's North Slope and its adjacent seas. The STAP provides advice and recommendations to NSSI regarding priority research and monitoring needs for management decisions.

The meeting will include continued review of emerging issues on the North Slope, and application of the North Slope Scenarios implications to inventory, monitoring and research priorities.
